SPECIFICATIONS

1. General – **Bids will be received at the North Penn School District Support Services Center, 630 W. 8th St., Lansdale, PA 19446 until 2:00 pm on Thursday May 17, 2018.**

The North Penn School District solicits bids for asphalt paving requirements for the 2018-2019 school year. Work on the proposed projects will be done as required for the period from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. Each bid will be based on per square yard, per gallon or per linear foot unit costs for the specified work to be completed. The work will be performed at the following buildings:

2. Conditions

- A. Furnish all tools, equipment, labor and materials and perform all operations necessary for the complete paving of the work of this section in strict accordance with these specifications.
- B. During the course of the installation, the contractor shall not allow debris from his work to accumulate at the project. At the completion of his work, all excess material and all debris caused by the paving shall be removed from the site by the contractor. Any damage caused by the contractor to existing North Penn School District property shall be repaired by the contractor, including backfilling and seeding areas adjacent to new paving at his expense prior to final payment for work completed.

- C. Guarantee: The contractor shall furnish a written one-year guarantee as of the date of acceptance of the paving by the owner, covering repair or replacement due to defects in workmanship or materials.
- D. Pre-Work Visit: The successful bidder is to examine job conditions, review job requirements, and determine exact area dimensions prior to starting work. Appointments for on-site visits can be made by contacting:

- E. CLEARANCES: The successful Bidder must supply to North Penn School District documentation required by Act 34, Section III of the Public School Code (Criminal Record Check) and Act 151, Chapter 63 of 23 PA Consolidated Statutes (Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance) and Act 114 (FBI Fingerprinting Clearances) before work on a project shall begin. These forms must be current for every worker on site at all times.
- F. Contractor must enclose a copy of their current commercial liability insurance certificate with your proposal.
- G. All bidders must complete the attached Non-Collusion Affidavit.

3. Quality Assurance

- A. Contractor shall supply PennDOT approved HMA or WMA specifications and mix designs from their supplier.
- B. Contractor must have a minimum of five years of experience.
- C. Contractor must provide a list of 10 references of similar work with a contact person and phone number.
- D. No subcontracting is permitted.

4. Safety

- A. Safety of students, staff and visitors is paramount in executing this contract. The contractor should never compete with school activities to continue/complete his work. If necessary, this contractor will return to occupied areas after normal working hours.
- B. All work under this contract must follow ALL state and federal environmental rules and regulations.

5. Type of Asphalt Paving for Which Bids Are Solicited

- A. PARKING LOT /ROADWAY WORK:

- 1) Furnish and install 2" ID-2 Wearing course includes Cleaning and prep area, apply Tack coat to the area, and installing 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing Course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

- 2) Excavate/Mill asphalt to a depth of 4", dispose excavation off-site, clean area, install 2" ID-2 Binder Course asphalt, apply Tack coat, and install 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

Bid price per Square Yard _____

- 3) Excavate/Mill asphalt and stone base 10" and dispose off site, compact sub grade, install 6" 2A modified stone, 2" ID-2 Binder Course after compaction, apply Tack coat, install 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing Course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

Bid price per Square Yard _____

- 4) Excavate soils 10" dispose off-site, compact sub grade, install 6" 2A modified stone, 2" ID-2 Binder Course asphalt after compaction, apply Tack coat, and install 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

B. ASPHALT WALKWAY/PLAYING AREAS:

- 1) Furnish and install 2" ID-2 Wearing course includes cleaning and prep area, apply Tack coat to the area, and installing 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

- 2) Excavate/Mill asphalt to a depth of 4", dispose excavation off-site, clean area, install 2" ID-2 Binder Course asphalt, apply Tack coat, and install 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

- 3) Excavate/Mill asphalt and stone base 10" and dispose off site, compact sub grade, install 6" 2 A modified stone, 2: ID-2 Binder Course after compaction, apply Tack coat, install 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing Course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

Bid price per Square Yard _____

- 4) Excavate soils 10" dispose off-site, compact sub grade, install 6" 2A modified stone, 2" ID-2 Binder course asphalt after compaction, apply Tack coat, and install 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

C. POTHOLE REPAIR:

- 1) Neat cut area, excavate asphalt 10" and dispose off-site, install 6" 2A Modified stone, 2" ID-2 Binder course asphalt after compaction apply Tack coat and install 2" after compaction of ID-2 Wearing course. Seal seams, curbs, manholes, etc. with AC20.

- 1) Perform asphalt joint and crack sealing in accordance with PennDOT Pub 408 Section 469 using rubberized joint sealing material specified in Section 705.4(c).

Instructions:

1. This Non-Collusion Affidavit is material to any contract awarded pursuant to this bid. According to the Pennsylvania Antibid-Rigging Act, 73 P.S. 1611 et sec., governmental agencies may require Non-Collusion Affidavits to be submitted together with bids.
2. This Non-Collusion Affidavit must be executed by the member, officer or employee of the bidder who makes the final decision on prices and the amount quoted in the bid.
3. Bid rigging and other efforts to restrain competition, and the making of false SWORN statement in connection with the submission of bids are unlawful and may be subject to criminal prosecution. The person who signs the Affidavit should examine it carefully before signing and assure himself or herself that each statement is true and accurate, making diligent inquiry, as necessary, of all other persons employed by or associated with the bidder with responsibilities for the associated approval or submission of the bid.
4. In the case of a bid submitted by a joint venture, each party to the venture must be identified in the bid documents, and an Affidavit must be submitted separately on behalf of each party.
5. The term "Complementary Bid" as used in the Affidavit has the meaning commonly associated with that term in the bidding process, and includes the knowing submission of bids higher than the bid of another firm, any intentionally high or non-competitive bid, and any other form of bid submitted for the purpose of giving a false appearance of competition.
6. Failure to file an Affidavit in compliance with these instructions may result in disqualification of the bid.
