What Is NPAGE?

NPAGE, Inc., the North Penn Association for Gifted Education, is a non-profit incorporated educational organization which works on behalf of gifted students, their families, their teachers, their educational administrators and friends of gifted education in the North Penn community.

NPAGE, Inc. is an affiliated chapter of PAGE, Inc., the Pennsylvania Association for Gifted Education, which shares information statewide on developments in gifted education.

Who should join NPAGE?

Members of NPAGE can be parents of gifted and advanced students in the North Penn School District; educators of the gifted, which includes both teachers and administrators; as well as advocates of gifted education.

Annual renewal and new family dues for NPAGE are just \$10.00 per family per year, no matter how many children are identified as gifted, and \$5.00 per year for teachers and Maven student members.

Where are NPAGE meetings held?

Our meetings are often held in the Educational Services Center, ESC, at the corner of Hancock and Church Streets in Lansdale, PA. Other meetings or events may be held at various schools within the district.

Examples of NPAGE events include:

- ❖ **Back to School Night** - an opportunity to learn more about the gifted program at North Penn, meet other parents and talk to district staff
- ❖ **Game Night** - a fun night that allows gifted students across the district to interact
- ❖ **Parent Shares** - a chance for parents to meet and discuss topics around raising gifted and advanced children
- ❖ **Transition Night** - gifted students and their parents meet our middle school gifted team of teachers and students from each middle school
- ❖ **Super Saturday** - one day program offering a multitude of diverse workshops to students in grades K through 6
- ❖ **Guest Speakers** - hear from district staff and other experts on a variety of topics
- ❖ **Environmental Education Day** - An exciting day of environmental learning for gifted 4th graders

NPAGE meetings and events provide an atmosphere for open discussion and sharing of ideas pertaining to issues relating to giftedness and appropriate educational programming for gifted and advanced students.

* We invite faculty and outside speakers to address concerns on a wide range of subjects. Topics at meetings have included curriculum updates, tips for understanding the GIEP procedure, SAT preparation, academic acceleration, social/emotional needs, underachievement and more.

* We provide information to parents who have questions regarding the identification of giftedness and the resources available to students in our school district. We also provide a forum for parents to share and increase their knowledge of gifted issues.

* We maintain and award funds for scholarships for graduating gifted North Penn seniors, and special mini-grants to gifted teachers for special projects and field trips.
